A Gloversville woman was arrested Monday for allegedly falsely reporting a rape, according to police.

According to the Gloversville Police Department, 23-year-old April Fox reported to police Sunday that she had been forcibly raped by a family member.

After an investigation, Fox admitted in a second interview Monday that she had fabricated the story “because she was mad at the accused,” according to police.

Fox was charged with falsely reporting an incident in the third degree, a misdemeanor.

She was arraigned in the City of Gloversville Court before Judge Traci DiMezza and released. She is scheduled to reappear in court at a later date.
