

Report of sex assault at APSU turns out false

A reported sexual assault by a stranger at Austin Peay State University on Nov. 10 turned out to be false.

"After further investigation, it was determined that the events as described did not occur," APSU Police Chief Michael J. Kasitz said Tuesday in a campus safety alert.

In response to the initial report, APSU had sent out a campus safety alert on Nov. 11. The victim told police the incident occurred between the first floor (North) entrance of the Morgan University Center and the Ellington Building on Nov. 10.

There was no description of a suspect.

The student has since changed her story.

"The person who reported the incident advised APSU police officers that she was not assaulted by an unknown subject in that area," Kasitz said Tuesday. "The Austin Peay State University Police Department will continue investigating this incident."
