Woman Arrested For Making False Rape Claim

A Stuart, Virginia woman has been arrested by Johnson City detectives for filing a false report. 19 year old Jenny Wright told police that she was sexually assaulted Sunday. She claimed that a man she knew wanted to have sex and she refused. Wright told cops that the man then slapped her in the face. She had no marks on her face to validate her claim. Other statements made by her were inconsistent. Arraignment for Wright is scheduled for today. (jb)

Woman Arrested For False Rape Claims

A woman trying to hide an affair from her husband has now been arrested. Last month, Kimberly Evans told deputies at the Sullivan County Sheriff's Office that she had been raped on two different occasions, once in June and another time in August. Evans said the rapes happened at Warriors Path State Park by two different men. Later during an interview with Detective Cindy Adams, Evans confessed that neither of the alleged rapes happened and that she had made up the entire story. As a result Evans is charged with two counts of filing a false report. She turned herself in at the Sullivan County Correctional Facility this morning. (JH)

Woman Charged Filing False Rape Report

Johnson City police investigators have charged a woman with filing a false police report. 29 year old Christine D. Bolyard had reported that she had been raped on June 3rd.
