



## HCPD: Victim lied about sexual assault

HORRY COUNTY, SC (WMBF) – The Horry County Police Department has arrested a 19-year-old Myrtle Beach woman accused of filing a false police report Friday.

According to arrest warrants obtained by WMBF News, Ayanna Chamesha Dozier told police she had been the victim of a sexual assault and rape along Highway 17 Bypass.

Dozier claimed a man named "Joe" had held her against her will and repeatedly assaulted her. According to the warrant, Dozier also accused Horry County officers of misconduct, claiming they did not take the correct action when she reported the assault.

Further investigation reportedly discredited Dozier's allegations. When questioned, Dozier allegedly "admitted she lied" about the assault.

Dozier was then arrested and charged with filing a false police report of a felony violation.

Online booking records with the J. Reuben Long Detention Center indicate bond for Dozier was set at \$5,000. She remains incarcerated at this time.

No arrests were made as a result of Dozier's allegations.
