

ANDHRA PRADESH: DIFFERENTLY-ABLED WOMAN FILES FALSE RAPE CASE TO ESCAPE PARENTS' SCOLDING, CLAIM POLICE

Hyderabad: At a time when the nation is worried about atrocities on women, a rape complaint by a 21-year old physically-challenged woman in Andhra Pradesh's Vizianagaram district has kept the cops on their toes for three days. However, the detailed investigation by the police discovered that the allegations were 'false'.

In the meantime, the issue became political with the opposition YSR Congress Party criticising the government comparing the 'incident' to that of Kathua.

Finally, the woman confessed to the police that she had come up with the rape story to escape being pulled up by her parents for going home late.
