

Woman jailed after lying about early-morning abduction, lawmen say

A 24-year-old woman is behind bars this morning after lawmen say she lied about being kidnapped earlier today.

Tuscaloosa County Metro Homicide Unit investigators were dispatched about 2 a.m. to the 12000 block of Plowman Road on a reported abduction. When they arrived on the scene, Haylee Hopson told them she had been kidnapped from her home by two men and driven to a location on Old Fayette Road, said Lt. Kip Hart.

She told detectives that when the suspects got out of her vehicle, she was able to get into the driver's seat and flee. Hart said investigators processed the scene and interviewed Hopson.

During that interview, Hopson admitted she fabricated the kidnapping story because she was mad at her boyfriend over a relationship issue.

Investigators charged Hopson with false reporting and jailed her on \$3,000 bond.
