

Police officers close Wokingham rape investigation

Police officers have concluded an investigation after an alleged incident in The Paddocks car park.

Officers investigating an alleged rape in Wokingham town centre have closed the case with no arrests.

It was reported that a woman in her 20s was approached by two men on Bank Holiday Monday, May 28, while walking along a footpath which runs through the redevelopment of The Paddocks car park in Wokingham, Berkshire, and that one of them raped her. However, enquiries by detectives have established the incident did not occur as initially reported and have subsequently concluded.

No one was arrested in connection with the investigation.

Detective Inspector Jonathan Groenen, of Berkshire Force CID, said: "Thames Valley Police always takes reports of sexual offences extremely seriously and we work to establish the circumstances.

"Officers have been working with the woman who reported the incident to establish what happened and she is continuing to be offered support.

"We appreciate there has been an increased police presence in the area while officers have been working to carry out enquiries and I would like to thank the community for their understanding and patience while this has been ongoing."
