No action over Crewe footballers accused of Redruth rape



No action over Crewe footballers accused of Redruth rape

Devon and Cornwall Police have confirmed no further action will be taken against any of the seven Crewe Alexandra players accused of rape in Redruth.

The seven players aged between 18 and 35, who have not been named, were arrested in the summer after an allegation that a woman was raped at a property in the town in July.

Five Crewe Alexandra players were arrested in Cornwall and taken into custody. Two others were arrested later in Cheshire.

The group of more than 20 players from the club were in Cornwall for pre-season training.

Devon and Cornwall Police said all seven men were released without charge.

A statement on Crewe Alexandra FC's website said: "After conducting a thorough investigation, Devon and Cornwall Police have today confirmed that no action will be taken against any Crewe Alexandra players in relation to the alleged pre-season incident in Truro."
