



Woman charged with false report after saying 2 men assaulted her

COLUMBIA Co., Ga. (WRDW) -- A Columbia county woman made two false claims of sexual assault, Capt. Steve Morris with the Columbia County Sheriff's Office said.

Mindy Readdy, 32, is charged with accusing two men of sexually assaulting her, including her boyfriend.

Readdy told deputies her boyfriend put a knife to her throat and raped her in their bedroom on Oct. 31. The report said her boyfriend, Cody Carson, was arrested for aggravated assault until being released on Wednesday.

Readdy also told deputies in April that her friend physically forced her to give him oral sex. There was not an arrest made in that case.

Morris said both sex acts were consensual and Readdy has since told deputies she lied about the original claims.

She was arrested Wednesday and charged with two counts of false report of a crime and one count of making a false statement.

She has been charged with false report of a crime and false statements.
