

## Streetwalker tried to blackmail a stranger claiming false rape

A 41-year-old prostitute broke into a car to a stranger, threatening to call a pimp if he did not give her his money. The man called bluff and turned the police at the same time as the blackmailer, who claimed rape.

On November 1st there was an unusual case of an inept attempt to racketeering. According to affidavit, the County of Davidson police recorded 2 simultaneous reports in which a woman identified as Chrissy L Simpson claimed rape and a man told of a strange woman who refused to leave his car, demanding money "or she would call her friends to assault him."

After simultaneous calls, the injured man stayed in touch with the 911 dispatcher, while the woman stopped answering calls from the rescue service. The man victim reported the location and said that he would wait for the officers, at this time Simpson, realizing the hopelessness of the situation, decided to hide from law enforcements.

ON 11/1/2019 POLICE RESPONDED TO 1412 BRICK CHURCH PKE FOR A PERSON CALLING 911, AND STATING THAT SHE WAS BEING RAPED, AND A SECOND CALLER STATING THAT THERE IS A FEMALE IN HIS VEHICLE REFUSING TO GET OUT. POLICE ARRIVED AT THE LOCATION, AND NEITHER CALLER COULD BE LOCATED. THE SECOND CALLER CALLED BACK AND STATED THAT HE HAD RELOCATED TO 321 W. TRINITY LN, AND WOULD MEET POLICE AT THAT LOCATION. THE FIRST CALLER WOULD NOT ANSWER ON CALL BACK. THE SECOND CALLER STATED THAT THE DEFENDANT (FIRST CALLER) HAD GOTTEN INTO HIS VEHICLE, AND DEMANDED MONEY, OR SHE WOULD CALL FRIENDS TO ASSAULT HIM. THE VICTIM (SECOND CALLER) REFUSED TO GIVE HER MONEY, AND STATED THAT HE WAS GOING TO CALL 911 IF SHE DID NOT GET OUT OF HIS VEHICLE. WHEN THE VICTIM CALLED 911, THE DEFENDANT CALLED 911 FROM (931) 286-5328, AND STATED THAT SHE HAD JUST BEEN RAPED. THE DEFENDANT THEN EXITED THE VICTIM'S VEHICLE, AND FLED ON FOOT. THE VICTIM DESCRIBED THE DEFENDANT AS A HEAVY SET, FEMALE WHITE, WEARING A WHITE LACY SHIRT, AND CURLY BLONDE HAIR. THE DEFENDANT WAS SEEN CROSSING W. TRINITY LANE, AND STOPPED BY POLICE. THE VICTIM DENIED CALLING 911, AND REFUSED TO GIVE THE PHONE NUMBER FOR THE CELL PHONE, AND HAD TURNED HER PHONE OFF TO PREVENT 911 FROM CALLING BACK. THE DEFENDANT WAS POSITIVELY IDENTIFIED BY THE VICTIM FROM THE NEIGHBORING PARKING LOT AS BEING THE PERSON THAT HAD GOTTEN INTO HIS VEHICLE.

Chrissy L Simpson is currently being held at the Metro Nashville Jail. A pledge of \$ 5,000 was announced for a false report of rape. According to the accused's biography, Simpson was previously charged with prostitution and drug-related crimes.

At the moment, the police are ascertaining whether the suspect had an accomplice.
