University rape claim is withdrawn

Police investigating two allegations of rape at a university on the same night have said the latest complaint has been withdrawn.

Officers said that following inquiries into the rape of a 20-year-old woman at the University of Glamorgan, in Pontypridd, South Wales, they were no longer looking for suspects.

South Wales Police are still investigating the rape of an 18-year-old student on the campus, which happened on September 26.

A force spokeswoman said: "In relation to the alleged rape of a 20-year-old woman at the University of Glamorgan, South Wales Police can confirm that following inquiries we are no longer looking for suspects and the complaint has been withdrawn.

"Police are no longer investigating this incident. An officer has been assigned as a point of contact for the woman and is offering her support for unrelated matters."
